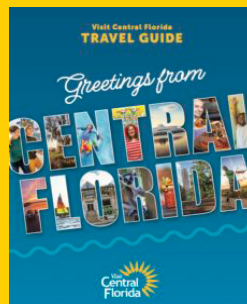

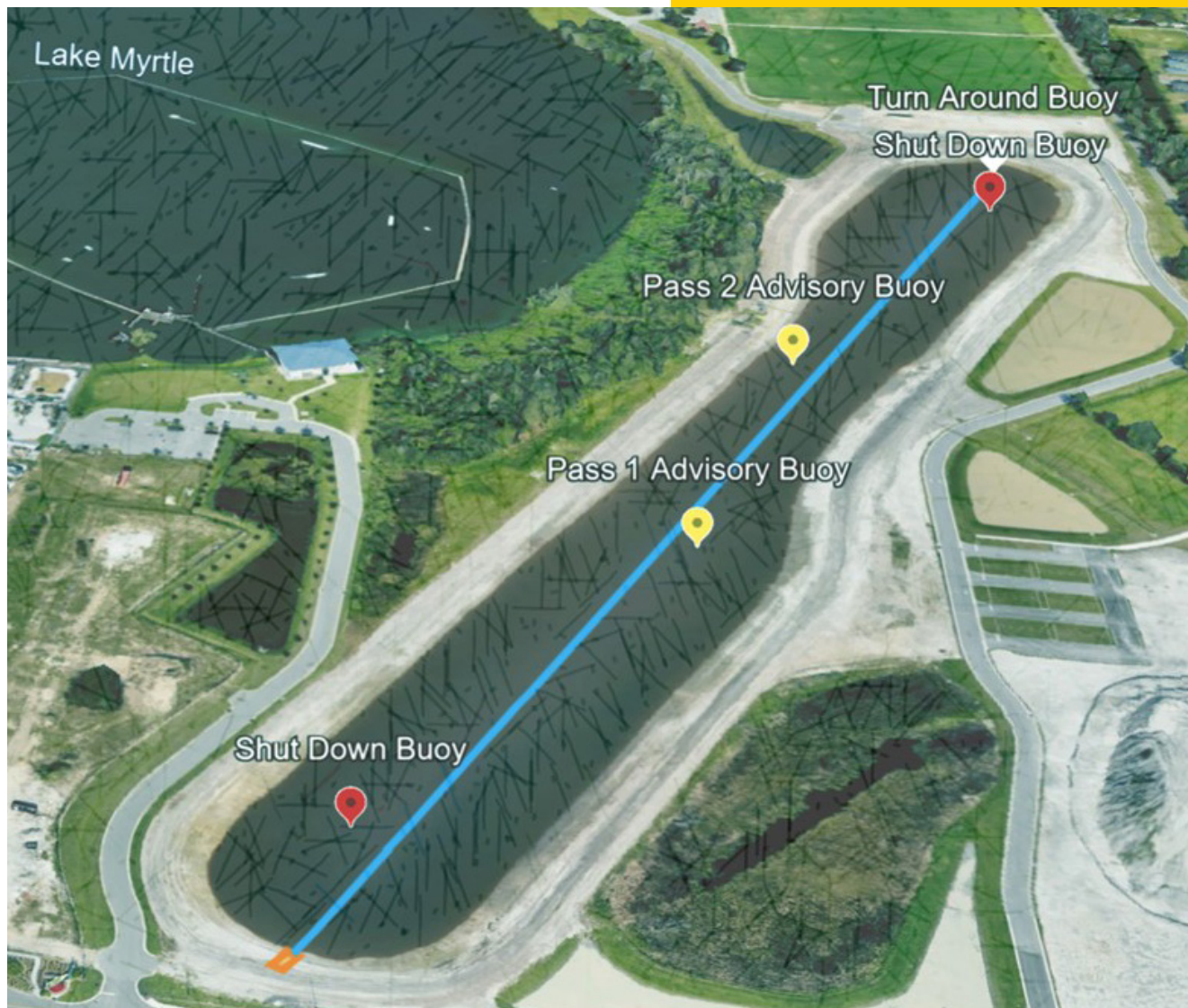
CHAMPIONSHIP LAKE, AUBURNDALE

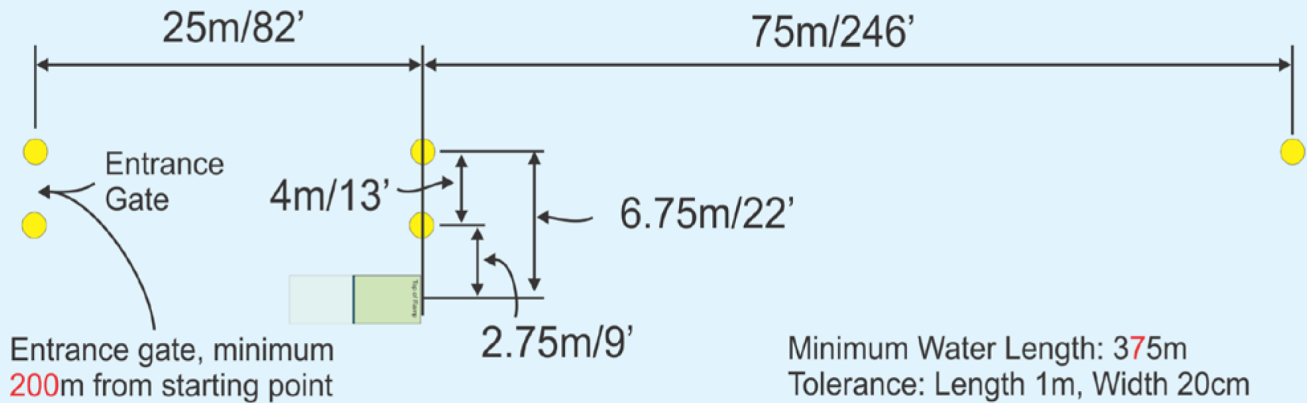
Championship Lake is a freshwater lake located within Lake Myrtle Sports Park. The lake is 2300ft long (701m), 300ft wide (91m) with a depth of 8-12ft (2-3.5m) in the middle. It is a private lake that stretches north to south with one point of entry at a private boat ramp.

SITE ENTRY

Entry to Lake Myrtle Sports Park is free. Food and drinks will be available for purchase on event days for spectators with local food trucks. Alcohol is not permitted in the park.



ANTI-DOPING

TEAM TENTS

Tents will be on site for teams and individuals. UV rays are most intense between 10am and 4pm (even on cloudy days). Cover up with light-weight clothing, a hat, use sunscreen and lip balm containing at least an SPF of 15.

7 ENTRY FORMS

SIGN UP TODAY!

Athletes must be entered by their respective Federations no later than **September 2**, which is 4 weeks prior to the event. Any Federation not meeting this deadline will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays to the WBC a fine of \$20 (USD) per skier per day for each skier not entered by the deadline, until such skier is entered. Federations must enter their athletes electronically via the EMS system (<https://ems.iwwf.sport/>). Payment should be made at time of entry via Paypal or credit card. Detailed instructions as to what information will be needed and how to enter using the EMS system will be sent separately via email to Federation Representatives.

TEAMS

Not later than 4 weeks before the scheduled start of the Championship, each Federation intending to enter a team shall certify the names of the skiers that will be skiing team member and the events each will enter in the EMS System. The names of up to two reserves for each team shall also be submitted as well. A Webcast Athlete Bio form and Payment button can be found in the EMS System as well.

INDIVIDUALS

Not later than 4 weeks before the scheduled start of the tournament, each Federation shall submit the names of any of its qualified independent skiers it wishes to enter, and the event or events they will enter in the EMS System. A Webcast Athlete Bio form and Payment button can be found in the EMS System as well.

FINAL LIST

Not later than 72 hours before the start of competition a Final Team List must be submitted in writing to the Chairman of the WBC and the Chief Judge. This list, which shall be comprised solely of skiers named in the EMS System, shall clearly indicate which are Team Skiers and which are Reserve Skiers as well as their relevant divisions. Failure to do so will disqualify the team from the team event.

PASSPORT REMINDER

Passports must be valid for six months beyond the date the traveler will exit the United States. Please visit our website with updated travel information for countries requiring a Visa Waiver Program (VWP), (ESTA) and B2 Visa.

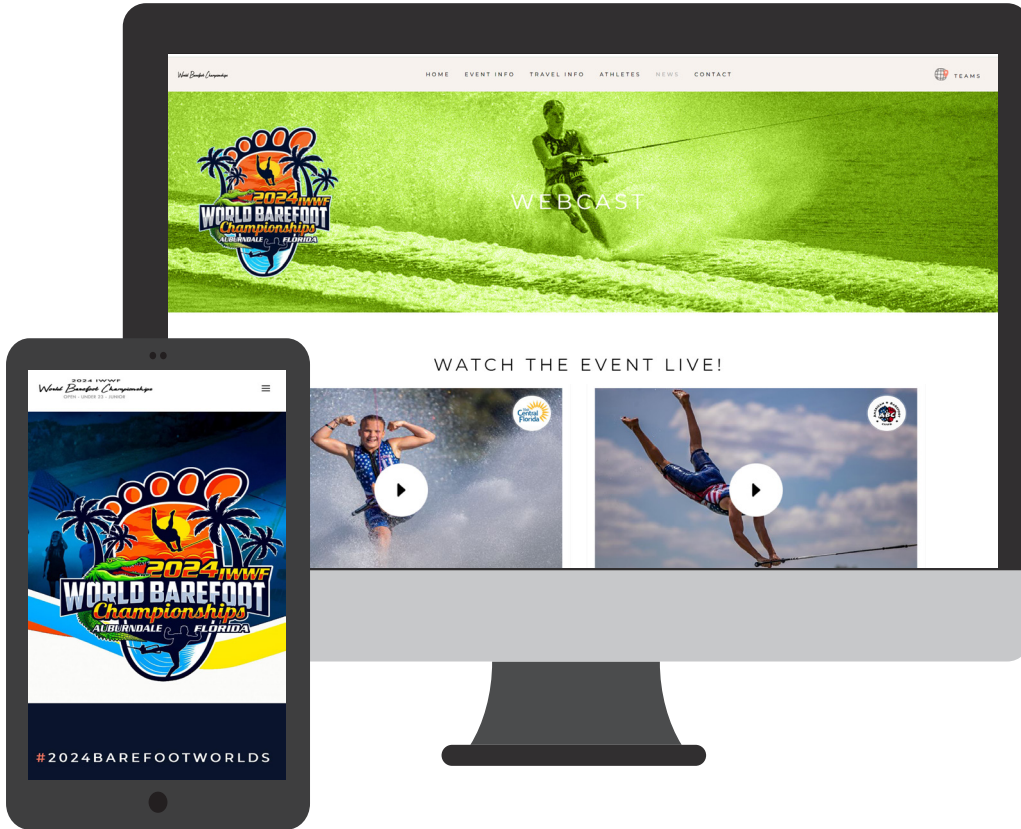

TRAVEL AND MORE

01 TRAVEL INSURANCE

The IWWF Bye-Law 16.1 states: It is the responsibility of each Federation when entering competitors for a World Titled Event to ensure that its competitors are adequately insured for personal accident, permanent disabilities, death and medical expenses.

02 INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

Make sure you have the right documentation before you travel internationally. If your country is part of the 40 countries that participate in the Visa Waiver Program, you are allowed to travel to the United States for business or tourism for stays of up to 90 days without a visa. If your country is not part of the 40 countries listed, then you will need to fill out an Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) form before travelling internationally. 03 EMERGENCY PERSONNEL

The event or LOC will provide emergency personnel certified in water rescue, recovery and transport during practice and competition. We will have certified paramedic and USA Water Ski and Wake Sports certified water safety personnel that will be available during practice and competition. Each team will be expected to receive and adhere to safety regulations set forth by the IWWF Safety Rules and Chief Safety Director.

04 IWWF SAFE SPORT POLICY & SAFEGUARDING REGULATIONS

The IWWF takes athlete safeguarding extremely seriously and is committed to ensuring that everyone who attends the tournament, whether athletes, officials or volunteers are able to operate in a safe environment, free from abuse and the risk of harm. 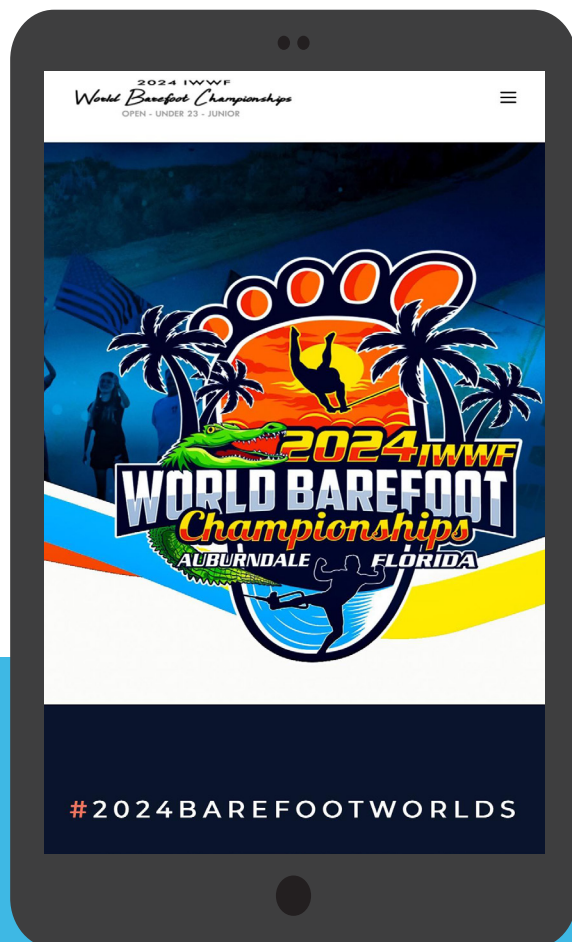
05 USA WATER SKI & WAKE SPORTS INSURANCE

All athletes are required to sign up as members of USA Water Ski & Wake Sports for insurance purposes before they are permitted to compete in the 2024 IWWF Open, U23 and Junior World Barefoot Water Ski Championships.
